The village is a one-hour train journey from London. It's particularly busy at Halloween.



Welcome. Our walking tour of Pluckley starts here at Pinnock Crossroads. Here, one cold October evening, two locals were going home when they suddenly saw a mysterious coach and horses travelling up the hill. If you listen carefully, maybe you can hear the coach approaching now ...

We are now outside the Black Horse Inn. This atmospheric pub was originally a farmhouse, and is home to the village poltergeist. One Sunday about ten years ago, while she was getting ready for opening time, the pub landlady noticed a glass moving along a shelf. Watch out! The cheeky poltergeist is

also famous for hiding people's possessions.

We are now in the Screaming Woods, a particularly eerie place when the full moon starts rising behind the trees. Only a few years ago, people heard the sound of screaming while they were walking here.

Our tour ends at St Nicholas' Church. In the early 1970s a group of psychic researchers spent the night here waiting for a ghost. While they were waiting, the vicar's dog came to visit them. They didn't realize until the next morning that the vicar didn't have a dog and that the dog ... was in fact the ghost ...
