## UK HOUSEWORK SURVEY: THE RESULTS!

Housework. Don't you just hate it? The problem is, *somebody* has to do it! What housework do you have to do?

Do you do more or less than your friends? And do you think that you do your fair share?

In a UK housework survey, thousands of teens at schools around the country answered questions about housework. The answers showed that the majority of us have to make our beds and tidy our rooms. Also, about half of us lay the table and do the washing-up. Only one in five of us helps to cook meals.

In general, it's clear that we're less lazy than our parents sometimes think. But it's also clear that girls do much more housework than boys. We do more ironing than boys, for example. And while twelve per



cent of boys don't have to help around the house, that's true for just four per cent of girls.

This situation is sad, but it isn't really surprising. It's a fact that women do more housework than men. But the future's in our hands! Are we going to copy our parents, or are we going to make the world a fairer place?
